


Get creative! Have a go at making a train. Use junk









- Think about what the little boy saw on the train ride. Can you draw pictures to show what he saw?

Can you draw your favourite part from the story?




Make some binoculars to take with you on your bear hunt?

What else will you need to take with you? Can you make a healthy sandwich to take on your Bear Hunt? Will you need anything to stay safe if it is a sunny day?










Can you design a beach picture? Create a background of sand and sea and use the pictures to cut and stick.













Number rhymes. We are learning number rhymes that count backwards and help us understand 1 less.

We are also learning about alliteration and matching words that sound the same. One of our favourite games to help with this is called 'Silly Soup'. It is easy for you to play at home.

You will need:

A large mixing bowl

A large spoon

Objects from your house that begin with the same sound and a few odd ones out e.g. spoon, sock, scarf, apple

This activity can be used in several ways, you could add ingredients that begin with the same sound or things that rhyme.

Each time you add an ingredient to the silly soup you can say this rhyme:

'I'm making lots of silly soup

I'm making soup that's silly

I'm going to put it in the fridge and make it nice and chilly'



Other ideas;

Name writing. Please encourage your child to hold a pencil correctly and to form letters correctly.

Dough disco. Play some music and practice patting, poking, rolling the dough.

Counting out sets of objects and matching to numbers.

Sports day races in the garden.
