fairy tale	A fairy tale is a magical story which usually begins with 'Once upon a time'. Fairy tales usually have a princess, magic spells etc.
pretend	To make - believe.
story map	A story map is a visual aid to help you to retell a story in the correct sequence.
Characters	A character is a person, animal or creature in a story.
Weight	How heavy something is.
Size	How large or how small, someone or something is.
Position	Where something is.
Sounds	Anything that people or animals can hear with their ears.
winter	The coldest season of the year. It comes between autumn and spring.

What happens next?  
Which part is your favourite?  
Who are the characters?  
What is the name of the book?  
Can you talk about different sounds you can hear?  
Can you describe the position of something?  
Can you compare the weight of 2 objects?  
Can you build a bridge?  
Can you find 3 items around your house and order by size?
