Key Vocabulary.

Seasons: There are differences in the weather, plants and trees change. The hours of day light change with each season.




Icicles: An icicle is a hanging piece of ice formed by the freezing of dripping water.



Character: A character is a person, animal or creature in a story.



Setting: The setting is where a story takes place e.g. a wood, a castle.



Winter: Winter is the coldest season of the year. The word winter means a time of water.



Freezing: When water turns from a liquid to a solid and forms ice crystals when it gets really cold.



Melting: Melting is the process of changing from a solid to a liquid.



Rhyming: Rhyme means words that sound the same or have a similar ending.
